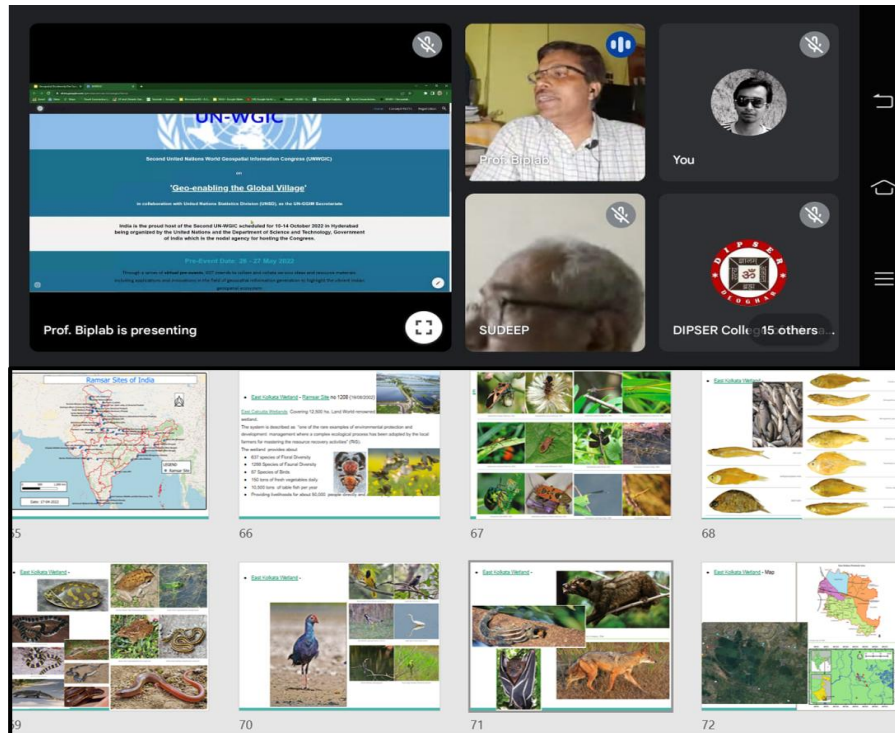


“Distinguished Lecture Series”

The 6th “Distinguished Lecture Series” lecture was organised by Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research (DIPSER College of Education for Women), Deoghar on 30th April 2022 on the topic " Importance of Geographical Information System (GIS) for (biodiversity): Characterization of Wetlands".
