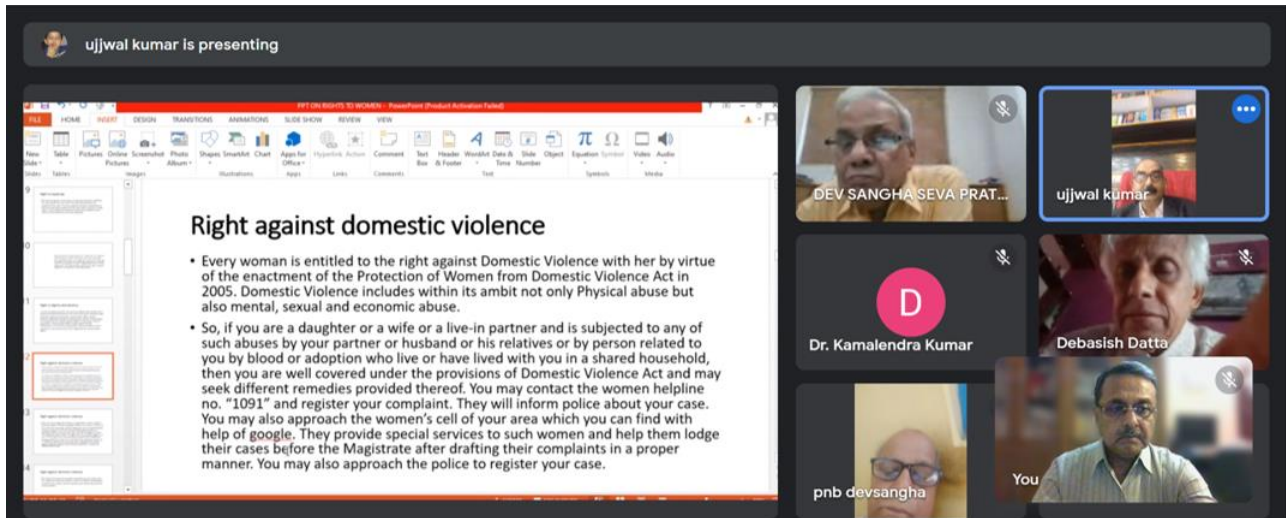


## “Distinguished Lecture Series”
