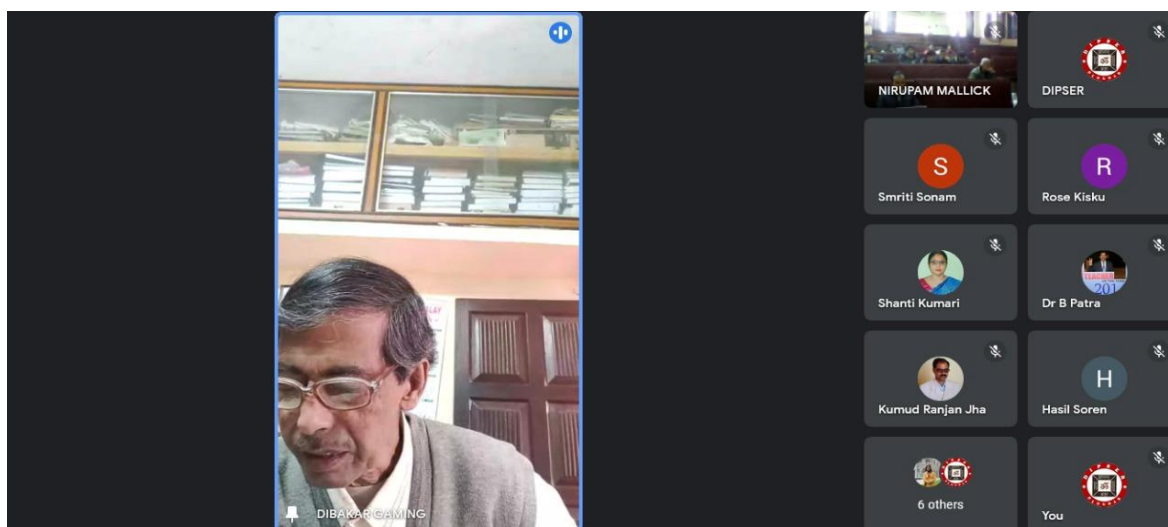

The 12th Distinguished Lecture Series was organised by Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research, Deoghar on 20th Dec. 2022 on the topic “National Education Policy 2020: An overview and proposed programme of Teacher Education”. The Lecture was delivered by Prof (Dr) Tarak Nath Pan, Former Professor, Visva Bharati University, Santiniketan, Emeritus Professor ICFAI University, Tripura and the Guest Faculty of Ramakrishna Shikshanmandir, Belur, West Bengal.

In his deliberations, Prof (Dr) Pan presented an elaborated picture of NEP 2020 with a special focus on the proposed programme of Teachers’ Education. He initiated his lecture with a brief description of the policy w.r.t. the basic structure of school education and then elucidated in details about the Four-year Integrated Programme of Teacher Education and Educational Research. He focussed upon the fact that by 2030 all stand alone colleges of teacher education need to be converted into general colleges with flexible offering of subject choice for students. He said that only the four-year integrated teacher education programme would be allowed and that would be in multi-disciplinary institutions only. He appreciated the Three Language Formula and the study of classical language at secondary level proposed in NEP 2020.

The lecture was highly interactive via online mode and was attended by Teachers and Students of Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and educational Research. The entire programme was anchored by Student Teachers of D.El.Ed. Smriti Soren and Shraddha Kumari.
