The 14th “Distinguished Lecture Series” was organised by Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research, Deoghar, on 17th March 2023, on the topic “**Cognitive Failure: Research in Education**”. The Lecture was delivered by **Dr. Subir Sen**, Associate Professor, Department of Education, S. K. B. University, Purulia, West Bengal.

Dr. Subir Sen presented a detailed picture of the issue of cognitive failure that almost every one faces some way or the other. He commenced his lecture by asking whether the students can recall what they have studied in last two days?” Dr. Sen emphasised that it was difficult for a normal average person to recall everything every time, and referred it as a cognitive failure. Further, he defined it as result lack of concentration and various causes of distraction. He elaborated that one of the greatest cause of distraction and cognitive failure is smart phone addiction among people in general and children in particular. He correlated cognitive failure with internet/smart phone addiction and, suggested the need to study the impact of such incidents in the form of educational research. He also recommended several research articles on such topics.

The lecture was highly interactive, and was attended by Teachers and Students of Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and educational Research. The entire programme was anchored by Student Teachers of B.Ed. Nidhi Kiran and Chandni Kumari.
