Dr. Pramodini Hansdak, focussing on the **Importance of Hindi Language in NEP 2020**, elaborated that Medium of Instruction in NEP 2020 explicitly states that Hindi shall be used as the medium of instruction in schools located in Hindi-speaking regions. This ensures that students in these areas will receive education in their native language, fostering a deeper understanding and appreciation for their cultural heritage. In non-Hindi speaking regions, the policy promotes a flexible approach. Despite its emphasis on Hindi, NEP 2020 has also faced some criticism related to concerns about imposing Hindi in non-Hindi speaking regions and potentially neglecting other Indian languages. It is important to note that the policy emphasizes flexibility and encourages a multilingual approach, balancing the promotion of Hindi with respect for regional languages and cultures.
