The 21st Lecture of Distinguished Lecture Series was organised by Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research, Deoghar, on 27th January 2024, on the topic “**Trajectory of Indian Education in Light of the Challenges of NEP 2020**”. The lecture was delivered by **Dr. Soumitra Roy, Retd.** Associate Professor, Department of English, Kazi Nazrul Islam Mahavidyalaya, Paschim Bardhaman, West Bengal, India

Dr. Soumitra Roy, focussing on the ‘**Trajectory of Indian Education in Light of the Challenges of NEP 2020**’ elaborated the journey of Education Policies of India right from the Charter Act 1813 & Macaulay Minutes 1835. He explained the journey of Educations Policies, their objectives and their implications. He focussed on the issues of challenges of each education policy side by side the global compulsion of the reformation stated in different policies including NEP 2020. He stressed on the various issues like traditional knowledge, vocational education & flexibility education etc. He described how British dominion destroyed Indian values system and indigenous knowledge system which NEP 2020 tries to re-establish by including Vedic Mathematics, Shastras, Astronomy, Bharatiya Khel, Yoga and Ayurveda.

The lecture was highly interactive, as it was in face to face mode, and was attended by teachers and students of Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research. The programme was anchored by Student Teachers of B.Ed. Ritu Roshni and Neha Jha.
