**Dr. Priyanka**, began her lecture by focusing on the need for and goals of cervical cancer screening by describing its various methods. She emphasized that early detection of cervical cancer will significantly enhances the survival rates among the female. She further elaborated on effective treatment, prevention, and vaccination strategies. She stated that the three-dose vaccine regimen should ideally be completed by women before reaching the age 45. She also mentioned that vaccination is beneficial for both males and females, as it helps them to prevent from other types of cancers as well.

The lecture was highly informative as well as interactive as it was in face-to-face mode and was attended by Teachers and Students of Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research.
