The 34<sup>th</sup> Lecture of Saumyendra Nath Brahmachary Distinguished Lecture Series was organised by Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research, Deoghar on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2025, on the topic “**First Aid before reaching Hospital**” by Dr. D. Tiwari, National Vice President, Indian Medical Association, New Delhi, India

**Dr. Tiwary** began his lecture with some basic principles and objectives of first aid. His lecture covered a range of critical topics, including immediate response techniques for bleeding, fractures, burns, and cardiac arrest. He discussed the common mistakes we should avoid in emergencies. He reiterated the importance of staying calm and composed during crises and how to communicate effectively with medical professionals and emergency services. He discussed the First Aids for Heart attack, Fainting, Drowning, Dog bites, Snake bites, how to feel the pulse of an individual at different places like neck, hand, leg etc. and CPR technique. He informed us that vaccines were available for snake bites and dog bites in the hospitals.

The lecture was highly informative as well as interactive as it was in face-to-face mode and was attended by Teachers and Students of Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research.
