The **35th** lecture of the Saumyendra Nath Brahmachary Distinguished Lecture Series was organized by the **Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research, Deoghar**, on **July 29, 2025**. The topic was "**Effective Teaching-Learning Strategies at the Secondary Level**," and the speaker was **Dr. Saroj Kumar Mishra, Ex-Deputy Director, Regional Centre IGNOU, Mandakini Sadan, Basuwadih, Deoghar, Jharkhand – 814142, India**.

Dr. Mishra began his lecture by discussing some basic concepts, principles, and objectives of teaching and learning. His lecture covered a range of critical topics, including teaching skills, teaching strategies, command over subject knowledge, knowledge of educational psychology, and theories of learning. He reiterated the importance of classroom management, discipline, using teaching-learning materials, and working on the board (black/white) in the classroom. He also discussed the role of a teacher in the classroom in detail. Dr. Mishra emphasized the role of a teacher as a facilitator, stating that a teacher must ensure learning among students. He elaborated on different strategies for making teaching and learning interesting, motivating, and effective.

The lecture was highly informative and interactive because it was a face-to-face event attended by teachers and students of the Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research.
