These goals are – 1) To strive continuously to improve the teaching-learning process by regular feedback of students and stakeholders adopting effective pedagogy. 2) To develop more inclusive structures and practices. 3) To promote research and innovation at all levels. 4) To establish green campus for sustainable ecosystem in the campus. 5) To provide adequate environment for faculty members to improve their Professional Competence. 6) To upgrade the physical infrastructure of the college to create an ecosystem conducive to teaching. 7) To create infallible and transparent system of examination. 8) Promote outreach and extension activities. 9) Administrative and Financial Transparency. 10) Outcome Based Education (OBE).

Dr. Kumar elaborated detailed strategies to achieve each goal to improve the overall quality of the institution. The main objectives of his lecture were improvement in NAAC Grade/Level through sincere efforts to earn good level in the scale of 1-5 as prescribed in Maturity-Based Graded Levels (MBGL) which is yet to be launched by NAAC, initiate efforts to broaden the horizon of ideas among the students by creating an open environment to exchange the ideas for decent quality of life in the society through regular seminars, workshops, elocution contest and outdoor visits to adjoining areas and to produce highly efficient and accomplished teachers to serve mankind.
