The 41st Lecture of Saumyendra Nath Brahmachary Distinguished Lecture Series was organised by Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research, Deoghar on the topic “**HIV, Personal Behaviour and Tuberculosis**”. By Dr. Sanchayan, DTO, Deoghar, Jharkhand, India on 31st January 2026 at 11:00 A.M. in DIPSER Auditorium.

Dr. Sanchayan based his lecture around awareness of people regarding HIV and Tuberculosis, the two most fatal diseases of the country against which the government of India has initiated free health services throughout the country. Dr. Sanchayan and his team elaborated detailed strategies of the expedition run by the government against HIV and TB. Dr. Sanchayan described the processes of infection, symptoms, investigation and treatment of both the diseases. He described that TB is the most fatal disease in India. It assumed that 42% of Indian population is carrying TB bacteria and the individual can be a patient if he/she loses his/her immunity. He described the mode of infection, its diagnosis and treatment. He informed us that the Deoghar Centre for tuberculosis is running awareness camp in different places of the district side by side the Centre is providing free diagnosis and treatment for the people of five nearby districts including Gridih, Jamtara, Dumka, Sahibgunj and Godda. Dr. Sanchayan emphasized the identification of the disease and its prevention. Proper personal behaviour is necessary to identify the infection and its prevention. Similarly, Dr. Sanchayan described the process of infection, diagnosis, treatment and prevention of HIV.

The lecture was highly informative as well as interactive as it was in face-to-face mode and was attended by Teachers and Students of Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research.
